Dear Secretaries

Over recent months, it has been brought to our attention that there have been errors in the AERA Rulebook. These have been assessed to be typographical errors and these have now been corrected. An updated version of the Rulebook is available on the AERA website.

The corrections that have been made are:

Rule 45.4

Acceptance of the minimum age & dentition of a horse at one *ride* does necessarily entitle the horse to be accepted at a subsequent *ride*.

has been corrected as shown in red, and reads,

Acceptance of the minimum age & dentition of a horse at one *ride* does not necessarily entitle the horse to be accepted at a subsequent *ride*.

Rule 60.2

On the first 12 month anniversary of an individual penalty being imposed, points are credited to the horse as below. Additional credits occur for the successful completion of *endurance*, *marathon*, *mini marathon and intermediate rides* as follows:

- 60.2.1 4 points for rides 40km and up to 59km
- 60.2.2 6 points for rides 60km and up to 79km
- 60.2.3. 6 points for rides 80 km up to 90 km.
- 60.2.4. 10 points for rides 91 km up to 120 km.
- 60.2.5 12 points for rides 121 km and up to 159km.
- 60.2.6 15 points for rides of 160km and above.

has been corrected as shown in red, and reads,

On the first 12 month anniversary of an individual penalty being imposed, points are credited to the horse as below. Additional credits occur for the successful completion of *endurance*, *marathon*, *mini marathon and intermediate rides* as follows:

- 60.2.1 4 points for rides 40km and up to 59km
- 60.2.2 6 points for rides 60km and up to 79km 60.2.3. 8 points for rides 80 km up to 90 km.
- 60.2.4. 10 points for rides 91 km up to 120 km.
- 60.2.5 12 points for rides of 14m and up to 159 km. 60.2.6 15 points for rides of 160km and above.

It has been confirmed that the database has been allocating points as was intended when this rule was changed. The numbering of 60.5 has also been corrected to match the text.

Please ensure that your members and officials are aware of these corrections and have access to the correct version of the AERA Rulebook.
