APPENDIX: 1 AERA correspondence

Following on from the AERA meeting last weekend, below are some points that need to be bought to your State Management Committee's attention:

1. Reminder from March 2017 meeting: IVT/Treatment reports are to be upload into AERAspace after the ride takes place. The Chief Steward, or a designated person at the ride, is responsible to give the reports to the State Registrar or Horse Welfare Officer to upload. States are to keep the hardcopy for 7 years.

It appears the some Chief Stewards are unaware of this. Please remind your CSs of this.

2. The AERA website has been updated with a Guide To Australian Endurance Vetting, and treatment Vet Information. There is plenty of easy to read information and videos to better understand the processes.

3. Rider scrolls. Can SMC's please advise Jo Bailey as to when they plan to present their rider scrolls, so Jo has as much time needed to prepare the scrolls.

4. Vet accreditation. Just a reminder that before a vet can be an accredited Endurance Vet, they need to have met certain criteria as documented in the Guide To Australian Endurance Vetting on the AERA website.

Also vet:horse ratios:

15. VET TO HORSE RATIO

15.1 When identifying the number of veterinarians required for an event, the ROC shall include all expected entries in all rides being conducted at the event.

a) For events utilising the Standard ride control there shall be: i. a minimum of 2 veterinarians for the first 60 horses or part thereof, and ii. an additional veterinarian for every additional 30 horses.

b) For events utilising the VGIH ride control there shall be: i. a minimum of 2 veterinarians for the first 30 horses or part thereof, and ii. an additional veterinarian for every additional 30 horses.

15.2 Not all appointed veterinarians need to be available for the pre-ride veterinary inspections.

And finally, regarding treatment vets:

25. VETERINARY TEAM

25.1 A sufficient number of veterinarians as required by Clause 15, shall be appointed by the ROC, preferably a minimum of 12 weeks prior to the event pursuant to Clause 14.1.

25.2 The veterinary team shall comprise as a minimum:

a) one AERA accredited veterinarian who shall be designated the head veterinarian and who controls all aspects of horse welfare. Whenever a horse is on course, the head veterinarian shall be at the ride base (or be readily contactable and be within a 15 minute commute of the ride base).

b) one designated 'treatment' veterinarian who is responsible to provide first aid treatment to any compromised or injured horse(s) and ensure that fluids, drugs and consumables are available at the ride base. Whenever a horse is on course, the treatment veterinarian shall be at the ride base (or be readily contactable and be within a 15 minute commute of the ride base).

c) a sufficient number of other accredited or non-accredited veterinarians as required by Clause 15.

5. State swabbing portfolio holders need to go through Dorte Colja for swabbing kits. After kit is used, reports need to go back to Dorte to tally up events swabbed.

APPENDIX: 2 AERA delegates report July 2017

Sandy and myself attended the AERA meeting in July, which as per usual went quite quickly. We managed to cover everything on the agenda, even with people having to leave earlier on Sunday due to the security scare at Sydney airport.

There were quite a few messages to take back to SMC's, which you have already received by the SMC notes sent out at the start of August. On top of that, there are a few advancements, and problems around the country.

Hendra is still pulling the state of Qld apart. This doesn't affect Vic too much, but may be more of an issue closer to the TQ19. Vax only rides are becoming more popular, as it is very hard to get vets to attend the 'open' rides, ie rides open to horses that are unvaccinated. There is also the problem of paperwork regarding registering the Hendra vaccination. Some vets are vaccinating as instructed, but are not registering the injections, making it hard for the owner to provide proof of vaccination. TQ19, if held at Stirling Crossing, is in a Hendra area. If anyone here is choosing to vaccinate, please ensure your vet registers the vax appropriately.

There seems to be a lack of consistency with rest orders. There needs to be a general guideline in place for vets to work with between themselves, and the States. Currently a horse can get 16 weeks for something in one state, and the same reason for another horse only gets 6 weeks. We are working with the National Vet Panel so there are clearer guidelines for our Vets.

Rule changes. There have been some rule changes that have passed their first vote, but as of today (7/8/17) I have not received the minutes as yet. Hopefully by meeting time, I can email everyone with the updates.

AERA liked the HEWS stickers, they wanted more to take back to their SMC's. Again, would like a report after they have been used at the 3 allocated rides.

We asked if there could be a Working With Children button on AERAspace for ride secretaries. That can be done, no issue, but we need to work out how it is managed. Is there an ID number, expiry dates etc? Who manages that?

An interesting forward move from WA. They have their General Meeting half yearly. They see that it can be a problem having to wait almost one year to resolve some issues, and during that time, the reasons can be forgotten, or another issue over rides the original. They have their half yearly general meeting, where the members can have their say, and vote accordingly.

The AERA website will be changed shortly to include the list of people that have achieved over 10,000 endurance kms. This will give people more of an idea of who our 'legends' are, and hopefully make those people apply for their scrolls. Again, we need to contact our membership to ensure all data is accurate in AERAspace, so members can apply for their scrolls
